| Plant | Latin Name | Recommended Cultivars | Landscape Value | Notes |

| Groundcovers/Vines: | | | | |
| Strawberry | <i>Fragaria x ananassa</i> | Earliglow, Catskills, Allstar, Gem, Alexandria | Attractive groundcover or potted plant, white blooms in spring | Summer-fruiting, everbearing, or alpine varieties available |
| Table grape | <i>Vitis vinifera</i> | Einset, Canadice, Remaily, Orlando Seedless, Perlette | Beautiful fall color, great for training over a trellice or arbor. Can harvest vines in winter for wreathes | |

| Blueberry | <i>Vaccinium corymbosum</i> | Premier, Tifblue, Climax, Coville, Sunrise | White, bell-shaped blooms in spring, beautiful flame-red fall color | |
| Raspberry | <i>Rubus idaeus</i> | Boyne, Dundee, Cumberland, Golden Harvest | Makes a nice border plant, combined with blackberry | Summer or fall-fruiting available |
| Blackberry | <i>Rubus fruticosus</i> | Brazos, Cheyenne, Chester, Hull, Olallie | Good edible border plant, to block unwanted views. White blooms in spring | Thornless varieties available |

| Fig | <i>Ficus carica</i> | Celeste, Calimyrna, Alma, King, Conoadria | Can form into a bush or tree, large smooth leaves and smooth bark add variation in landscape | |
| Apple | <i>Malus sylvestris var. domestica</i> | William's Pride, Freedom, Jonafree, Liberty, Winesap | White-pink blooms in spring, can train along wall or fence as espalier | |
| Pear | <i>Pyrus communis var. sativa</i> | Ayres, Moonglow, Lincoln, Magness | Great espalier tree | |
| Peach | <i>Prunus persica</i> | Bonanza, Compact Redhaven, Garden Sun, Babygold No. 5 | Naturally smaller-stature trees. Spring blooms | |
| Sweet cherry | <i>Prunus avium</i> | Compact Stella, Lapins, Black Gold, Black Republican | Beautiful white-pink blooms in spring, bark texture adds contrast in landscape | |
